Q: WHAT MAKES THIS TERMINAL FAMILY UNIQUE?

A: The Optimum T4200 terminal family from Hypercom is the first POS terminal line to incorporate the most robust features, secure architecture and communication options required by today's demanding markets. In addition, all Optimum T4200 models are developed using the same software toolkit to provide multiple solutions to customers faster than ever before!

O: HOW IS THE T4210 DIFFERENT FROM THE COMPETITION?

A: Unlike other dial devices, the Optimum T4210 has high-end features normally found in only more expensive IP and wireless models such as 24MB of total memory, an ARM9 fast processor and also fully functional multi-application. Some competitive products limit you to a single application or only one additional application. The T4210 also has an integrated PCI PED approved PIN pad so that you can support PIN-based debit with or without an external PIN pad. The T4210 is an affordable dial solution without limits.

Q: DOES THE TERMINAL FAMILY SUPPORT MULTIPLE APPLICATIONS? HOW MANY?

A: Every T4200 model supports multiple applications. This means that even the dial model allows you to load as many modules as you need for value-added applications such as gift, loyalty, check or dynamic currency conversion. The terminal will hold as many applications as the memory will allow - all 24MB total memory!

Q: WHAT ABOUT CUSTOM APPLICATIONS? CAN THEY BE DEVELOPED?

A: Yes. In fact, the toolkit for the T4200 will also serve the Optimum M4100 Blade and existing T4100 models. You can now write a wide array of value-added applications to serve multiple Hypercom terminal models.

Q: IS THE T4210 SIMILAR TO YOUR OTHER DIAL TERMINALS?

A: The Optimum T4210 supports all the features of previous Hypercom dial models, but adds real value and a greatly reduced total cost of ownership for Hypercom customers.
